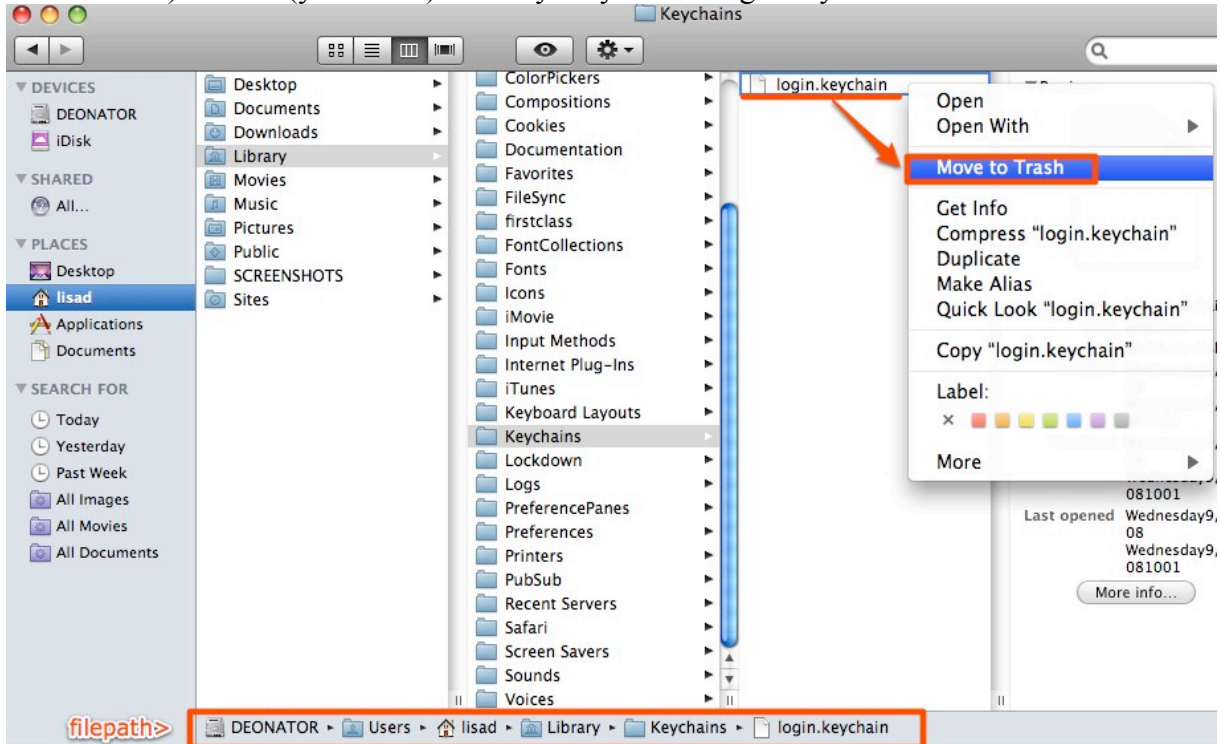


Removing an Old Keychain:

Your keychain is a tool used by your computer to store your frequently used passwords. If you are experiencing trouble where your keychain does not remember the password you entered (for example, it asks for the BFSW network password each time you connect), you may want to remove it and restart your machine. This process will restore a new keychain to your system.

- 1) Find your current login keychain. It is located in HD (hard drive)>Users>(yourname)>Library>keychains>login.keychain



- 2) While you have your keychain selected, use the Ctrl + Click (mouse pad) shortcut to move your keychain to the trash.
- 3) Restart your computer. Your keychain will be replaced.
- 4) If you were experiencing trouble with the BFSW network, your connection will now happen automatically, or you may need to re-enter your administrative password to the new keychain when prompted. (Your administrative password is the same used to login to your laptop. You are only an administrator on your laptop machine.)
